Job Description – Wellness Support Lead:

The El Nidito Wellness Support Lead position is specifically intended to provide ECT coverage and support to promote the wellbeing of El Nidito ECE classrooms. Under the supervision of the Early Childhood Education Director, El Nidito Wellness Support team members are responsible for providing coverage and classroom support while ECE classroom teams are participating in curriculum development and lesson planning, coaching, team meetings, and reflective practice. While in the ECE classroom, the Wellness Support team are responsible for implementing experiences based on current lesson plans provided by the classroom team.
