Job Description – Early Childhood Infant Teacher:

The Lead Early Childhood Infant Teacher, under the supervision of the Early Childhood Education Director, is responsible for planning and implementing early learning and care experiences that advance the development of children, ages 6 weeks through 18 months. They will work in collaboration with their classroom Co-Teacher to provide effective and nurturing teacher-child interactions, plan and implement learning experiences that ensure curriculum implementation and use of assessment, and promote children’s progress across the standards described in the Head Start Early Learning Outcomes Framework: Ages Birth to Five and applicable state early learning and development standards including for children with disabilities and English Language Learners. **This is a full-time, year-round position.**

Education/Knowledge & Experience Minimum Qualifications:

- Early Childhood Lead Teacher Qualifications set by the Colorado Office of Early Childhood
- Minimum of 6 months experience working with children 6-weeks through 18-months of age
- Ability to apply Early Child Development theory in daily classroom activities and adapt to the individual needs of children
- Preferred: Baccalaureate or advanced degree and coursework equivalent to a major relating to early childhood education
- Bilingual English/Spanish a plus but not required
